The HOD Dr. J. Pardhasaradhi read the proposed Academic regulations.

After the discussion the following conclusions were drawn:

- 1. As per clause in section 3.3 a specialization will be offered if the strength of students opting for it is 12.
- 2. Open electives were proposed to be offered in the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> semesters, after a lot of debate and discussion it is resolved that it will be offered in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> semesters.
- 3. Offering Production specialization was unanimously accepted.

- 4. (i) Accordingly subject titles like "Business Law and Business Environment" was replaced by "Business law and Regulation". "Training and development" was replaced by "Learning and development".
  - (ii) Certain subjects were shifted from one semester to the other, like "MIS and ERP" was shifted from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> semester and the subject "Strategic management" was shifted from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> semester to accommodate the open electives.
  - (iii) Open electives proposed included subjects like International Business, Online payment, Corporate governance, Business ethics.

All these points were accepted by the Chairperson and members.
