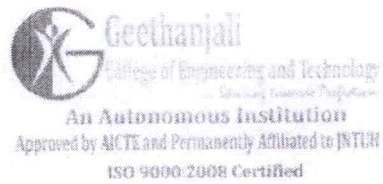

And

GEEETHANJALI COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING & TECHNOLOGY ("GCET"), having its campus at Cheeryal (V), keesara (M), Medchal District, Telangana – 501301. **SMARTBRIDGE** and **GCET** are sometimes hereinafter referred to individually as "Party" or collectively, as "Parties".

Background

SMARTBRIDGE is an educational services company specialized in building the next-generation talent pool with skills in emerging technologies. SmartBridge proven project-based learning model has enabled thousands of students with emerging skills and helped them in becoming career ready. Since inception, the SmartBridge has served 325+ engineering institutions, 60k+ students and 10k+ educators. SmartBridge has been setting up technology innovation centers (IoT, AI, Robotics) across various institutions to promote research & innovation in universities. Following are the core services of SmartBridge.

SmartBridge has built a unique edTech product called "SmartInternz" to prepare the students for the industry by building their skills via project-based learning.

Geethanjali College Of Engineering & Technology ("GCET"), established in 2005, is offering Under Graduate (UG) and Post Graduate (PG) programs in different disciplines


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of Engineering. GCET is dedicated to transforming the students into highly competent engineers with high level of motivation, professional skills and self-confidence.

GCET has established an Industry Institution Interaction Cell to forge alliances with industries and educational institutions. There are six different engineering departments, which are running undergraduate program, with CSE department offering a PG program also.

Depending upon the specializations, the heads of the departments approach the industries related to their departments and forge alliances with them for R & D activities found to be useful to the industry and the institution. At times the consultancy work is also taken from the industries depending upon the capabilities of the faculty and the availability of infrastructure in the institution and the complexity of the problem. Besides the alliances forged by the individual departments, the college also entered MoU with certain industries and educational institutions.

Both SMARTBRIDGE and GCET of Hyderabad, Telangana recognized the need for:

- 1) Pooling and sharing their knowledge and skills for constant development and upgrading in the field of Emerging Technologies.
- 2) Close cooperation between the industry and the technical education system
- 3) Educating & training of students, in practical environment, to enrich teaching methodologies, to help faculty development and to make the training more employment oriented.

In appreciation of the above and in the furtherance of the common desire for improving the quality of graduating Engineering students, SMARTBRIDGE and GCET have agreed to join hands. Both parties have explored the possibilities of building a synergistic relationship and have agreed to enter into MOU with the following joint responsibilities:

- 1) With a view to providing inputs to improve the quality of education and to impart industry related training, SMARTBRIDGE will provide their expertise on "Utilization of Lab & Incubation center" to GCET.
- 2) With a view to introducing students to industry, SMARTBRIDGE will provide "Academic Projects & Internships" to GCET students. Further, GCET students and faculty will participate in developing modules of a larger project and submit the completed work as consultancy project. To assist this activity GCET guide and

students will work in the premises of SMARTBRIDGE for the purpose of coding, assembly, integration, and testing of the project as and when required.

- 3) GCET will provide the required support in the survey of technical field, design, concepts and the methods of evaluation of the project.
- 4) SMARTBRIDGE will suggest the required changes in the curriculum and help GCET in providing education to its students as required by the industry.
- 5) Both parties agree to maintain confidentiality of information and the information can be released only with mutual agreement.

1. PURPOSE

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets forth the terms and understanding between the SMARTBRIDGE and GCET to engage in following activities.

- a) Establish a Robotics Learning & Development Center on the campus to train the students & faculty on building the intelligent robotics systems for Industry & Consumer sectors
- b) Set-up the necessary infrastructure, hardware components, software tools and learning resources for the successful operation of the center
- c) Engaging in consultancy work for a specific scope of services and product development which will be signed by both parties on need based terms.
- d) Professional certification & core elective programs in Robotics shall be designed & executed as part of academics.
- e) Foster innovation & entrepreneurship among the young engineers by organizing industry partnered hackathons and challenges etc.


2. SCOPE

a. Responsibilities of GCET:

GCET shall take up following responsibilities to establish & operate the Robotics Learning & Development Center.

- Budget for the entire program
- Provide a computer lab with minimum 30 Nos. of computers (Min. Intel i5 Processor, 8GB RAM, Ubuntu OS)

c. Program Deliverables

- 1 – Week training program on Python for ROS Programming
- 2 – Weeks Training Program on ROS Beginner
- 2 – Weeks Training Program on ROS Advanced
- 36 / 48 Hrs. Hackathon on Building Intelligent Robots
- Expert lectures on Industrial Robotics, Collaborative Robotics
- Access to 50 Nos. of Project Templates to students via SmartInternz
- Mentoring to the students participating in various hackathons
- Facilitating the internships to the best students

3. VALIDITY

This MOU is valid for Two (2) years from the date of signing of this MOU. Thereafter, the MOU may be renewed for such term and on conditions as may be agreed between the Parties.

4. NO ASSIGNMENT

Neither party, without the written consent of the other, may assign either the benefit or the burden of this MOU to anybody.

5. TERMINATION

Either party may terminate the MOU for cogent and logical reasons, by giving to the other party 30 days' notice in writing.

6. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

- a) This document represents the entire agreement between the Parties regarding the subject matter of this MOU and can only be amended or modified by an agreement in writing signed by the Parties hereto.
- b) A co-ordination committee consisting of one faculty member of GCET and one officer nominated by SMARTBRIDGE shall be constituted to implement and give effect to objectives of this MOU.

- Approval of Logo usage for the printing material, website etc.
- Hospitality for the trainers & industry experts
- Accommodation for the experts visiting the L&D center

b. Responsibilities of SMARTBRIDGE:

- a. Creation of Program Collaterals (Curriculum, Brochures, Lab Manuals etc.)
- b. Supply of Hardware for the L&D Center
- c. Supply of necessary Software tools & environment setup in the Lab.
- d. Preparation of training calendar & organizing the same as per the approved calendar.
- e. Mentoring students in building the Robotics projects
- f. Inviting Industry Experts to Robotics L&D Center
- g. Providing industry visits to the students
- h. Provide access to guided projects on SmartInternz Platform
- i. Organize internal hackathons for the students
- j. Mentor the students for external hackathons
- k. Facilitate internships for the students in relevant companies
- l. Coordinate with faculty & college management for the smooth execution of the program.

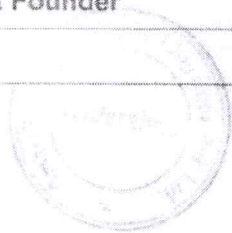

CONTRACT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT HAS BEEN EXECUTED ON THE 23rd DAY OF April 2021 BETWEEN

M/s. Geethanjali College of Engineering & Technology, having its campus at Cheeryal (V), Keesara(M), Medchal District, Telangana – 501301, hereinafter referred to as “College” or “GCET” and includes its successors and assigns.

AND

M/s. SmartBridge Educational Services Pvt. Ltd. having its corporate office at Plot No. 132, 2nd Floor, Above DCB Bank, HMT Nagar, Nacharam, Hyderabad, Telangana – 500076 hereinafter referred to as “Company” which expression shall unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning hereof be deemed to mean and include its successors and assigns.

Both GCET and Company are individually referred to as a “Party” and jointly as “Parties”.

WHEREAS

- A. Company is an EdTech company which offers outcome based experiential learning programs on emerging technologies for building skills for students bringing academia (faculty), technology partners and students together through internship programs (technology bootcamps, hands on training programs etc.) for students by partnering with institutions.
- B. Company also represents that it has necessary skills, technology infrastructure and partner engagement with leading technology industry partners (viz., IBM and Blue Prism through training and certification among other partners) that offer Externship Programs (defined later), through experiential learning to Students which provide them direct experience through which students can use analytical skills and apply new ideas from their experience in their classroom learning. These experiential learning includes externships, learning and upskill and provides practicum opportunities to the Students.
- C. GCET based on the aforesaid representations of the Company, has expressed its interest as an institution to avail externship services for the GCET students.
- D. The Parties now wish to collaborate with each other, to equip Students of GCET, with skills through externship projects in leading technology areas offered by industry partnerships facilitated by the Company, as per the terms and conditions mentioned herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, benefits and covenant contained herein and for other good and valuable considerations, the Parties, intending to be legally bound, hereby agree as follows:

In this Agreement, all capitalized words and expressions defined shall have the meaning ascribed to them as set out below:

1. SCOPE OF WORK:

Both the Parties are desirous to collaborate with each other to enable externship programs for the Students of GCET to build practical skills through Hands-on Projects as per terms and conditions of this Agreement and detailed scope of respective Externship Program as referred under **Annexure-1** to this Agreement.

This relationship between the Parties shall be on non-exclusive basis and either Party shall be free to explore similar relationship with other third parties.

Company agrees to offer Externship Programs to the Students through Company's partnerships with leading industry partners as mutually agreed to between the Parties, from time to time.

2. ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES:

2.1 COMPANY'S ROLE & RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Company agrees that it shall provide the following to each of the Students (collectively "Services")

- a. To create customized project workspace on the Smartinternz Platform ("Platform")
- b. Provide uninterrupted user access to the Students on the Platform.
- c. Identify and designate a single point of contact ("Company SPOC") with whom the GCET SPOC or Students can directly interact for the purposes of understanding any difficulties during the Externship Program. The Company SPOC shall conduct an orientation to the Students on usage of the Platform and all work activities planned, resolving all types of queries of the Students relating to the objectives and completion of the Externship Program.


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- d. To provide Externship Program to the interested Students, that ensures meaningful experiential working experience to each Student intern, covering:
- i. Provide access to online training materials on the relevant subject domain, approved by the industry required for the Students before they are assigned on Hands-on Project.
 - ii. Assign adequate number of mentors to the Students during their course of Externship Program to enable suitable projects are identified to be carried out by the Students.
 - iii. As part of the industry Partner collaboration enrolling Students to IBM Academic Initiative / Blue Prism University
- e. Ensure review of the Hands-on-Project deliverables of Students assigned to respective mentors designated by Company.
- f. Ensure review of the project documentation and approve the same.
- g. e-Certificate generation and distribution to Students upon completion of the Externship Program.
- h. Generating interim & final reports of the Externship Program

Shall maintain a high level of satisfaction with GCET and its Students in respect of Externship Programs offered, in terms of high-quality training materials, hands-on project with Industry Partners, standards of experiential exposure with adequate mentorship and guidance required from time to time.

2.2 GCET'S ROLE & RESPONSIBILITIES

GCET agrees and shall do the following:

- a. To assign a Single Point of Contact / faculty member to interact directly for the engagement and interactions with the Company
- b. To identify the Students with interest and abilities to pursue Externship Program as optional basis in addition to / as part of the academic curriculum of GCET.
- c. Confirm the Externship Program training calendar for a batch of Students at any time during an academic cycle.

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- d. To assign qualified Students with career interests in one or more domain offered under the Externship Programs.
- e. To designate a SPOC to Coordination with students for and conduct orientation of Students for Externship Programs and prepare them for experiential learning.
- f. To designate a SPOC to monitor the progression at each stage of the Externship Program for the Students and collect necessary feedback.

3. COMMERCIALS & PAYMENT TERMS:

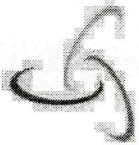
- a. In consideration of the Services provided by the Company as set forth hereunder and more specifically outlined in the Annexure-I hereto to the satisfaction of GCET, GCET agrees to pay for each registered Student an amount equivalent to **INR 4,000/-** (Four thousand Indian rupees) for the Services under this Agreement, plus all applicable goods and services taxes ("Service Fees"). The Service Fees include all costs, charges, (including any third-party tools or hardware, software) and expenses incurred by Company for providing the Externship Program.
- b. The GCET will pay Service Fees for Services rendered and within (15) days from date of receipt of Company's invoices. The invoices can be original signed hard copy or a scanned digitally signed soft copy (sent over an email from only the designated email ID of the Company).
- c. The payment of service fee shall be completed as per mutually agreed payment schedule as below:
 - a. 75% of total contract amount upon the completion of 40 Hrs. Training & the guided project activity
 - b. 25% of total contract amount upon the completion of mini project activity by the students.

4. REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES

4.1 The Company represents and warrants that:

- a. It has the right, power, and authority to enter into and perform all its obligations under this Agreement.
- b. It will perform the Services using reasonable care and skill in all material respects.

- c. It has valid and subsisting agreements with Industry Partners, and legally authorized licenses to offer the training materials on the Platform or to the Industry Partner software tools and technologies without any restrictions, whatsoever till the completion of the Externship Programs, by the Students.
- d. It will maintain proper and accurate records relating to the conduct of the Services, and shall at the request of GCET, provide to them, access to these records and copies to the extent necessary for audit purposes;
- e. The Platform and the software contained therein shall not distribute or transmit any virus, malicious code, or program of any nature during the delivery of the Services, that is unlawful, harmful, threatening, defamatory, obscene, infringing, harassing or ethnically offensive, facilitate illegal activity, promotes unlawful violence, discriminatory based on race, gender, colour, religious belief, in any manner hinder GCET's and its Students ability to avail the Services
- f. It does not violate and/or infringe any third-party rights of GCET and/or any person or entity in any way (including without limitation any intellectual property rights, privacy rights)
- g. The Services and the hand-on-projects offered shall at all times comply with all applicable laws, rules and regulations in force.

5. GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- a. Students with successful project submissions only will receive the certificates
- b. Entire program will be organized remotely via Zoom Meetings.
- c. Students must complete the e-learning courses assigned to them.
- d. Students must register in prior for the technical bootcamps as per the schedule.
- e. Students must complete the projects assigned to them without fail.
- f. Only e-certificates will be provided.
- g. The payments are non-refundable.

6. TERMS OF AGREEMENT:

This Agreement will commence on the Effective Date and will continue for a period of twelve (12) months unless terminated as provided hereto. The Agreement may be reviewed, and through the renewed only on mutual agreement of the Parties, as may be necessary to clarify and formalize roles, responsibilities, timelines, and assurances regarding the scope of work.
