Scholarship Policy

Introduction:

A Scholarship in the real sense of the word is financial aid given to a student because of academic merit with the purpose of encouraging such students in their academic pursuits. A number of scholarship schemes are sponsored by the Government of India and the State Govt. of Telangana without losing sight of the main purpose i.e. giving financial aid on the basis of merit. The Government of India judiciously recognizes the financial burden entailed on parents/guardians belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribe, who desire that their children/Wards continue and complete their education so as to ensure their future jobs and realization of their aspired careers. The diversity that makes up the fabric of our nation cannot overlook the fact that there are sections of society that need extra-financial boosts in order to ensure a gradual but steady upliftment through education. Thus added or extra consideration is given to girl students, differently abled students, students coming from Border villages. The minority status of a number of communities in the country are also given due consideration through different scholarship schemes sponsored by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India. The benign Government of India and the State Government of Telangana desire that students from all strata of society be given opportunities to empower themselves through education. This will lead to an enhancement of the chance of their being employable and ideally to realize a pan socioeconomic parity.

Apart from the above, the Institute has a number of Scholarships available to students based on academic merit, competitive spirit and benevolent status. Scholarships may be provided for partial or full tuition fees and the awarding of such Scholarships is at the discretion of the Management.

(a) The purpose of the academic merit aspect of the Scholarship is to provide students with a reward for academic excellence. Academic toppers of various departments (If student intake is 60, three students per year per batch per department and if intake is 240, five students per year per batch per department) were identified from exam branch depending on their percentages. Specific requirements and weighted averages are outlined in the conditions of each Scholarship.

(b) The purpose of the Scholarships based on the competitive spirit is to encourage individuals who are really interested to participate in campus training and placements for better future. Students must strongly exhibit their talent in their competitive spirit framework. Specific requirements are outlined in the conditions of each Scholarship.

(c) The purpose of the benevolent aspect of the Scholarships is to provide financial assistance to the students who are from rural back ground and with genuine and unpredictable circumstances which may include financial hardship (economically weak) and are likely to prevent the student from completing or continuing their formal education. Specific requirements are outlined in the conditions of each Scholarship. Depending on the request from the student, management decides the concession in tuition fee. The financial support provided by the management varies from case to case.
