### MS Education Abroad

Geethanjali College of Engineering & Technology gives high priority for MS education abroad. The institution is keen in motivating students through different Career counseling sessions. It focused on inviting Academicians and academic counselors from USA for greater awareness of the educational programmes abroad. Every year, more than 700,000 people take the Graduate Record Exam, commonly known as the Graduate Record Exam GRE from India. Most of our Geethanjalites are interested and also pursuing different educational programmes in different states of United States. A few successful students' details are given in this newsletter. The GRE is most commonly taken as a computer-adaptive test. On the computer-based test, the difficulty of the questions is based on the accuracy of the answers to the given questions. The level of questions vary from first sets of 20 verbal and quantitative reasoning. The better the student performs on the first sets of 20, the harder the next sets of 20 questions will be. The exam is broken down into three primary components: verbal reasoning, quantitative reasoning, and analytical writing. For the verbal reasoning section, test takers have two 30-minute periods to answer two sets of 20 questions.

Students aspiring for a commendable score in GRE should build for themselves a thorough basic knowledge in English and Mathematics and familiarity with the subjects right from schooling. They should be strong with the concepts learned in high school.—the verbal section will be easy if the aspirant has read enough in school to expand vocabulary and it will strengthen the aspirant because in verbal section the difficulty level rises as one moves ahead of the exercises. They should also develop a sense of Critical thinking. Critical thinking is something that's hard to change overnight because it's such a lifelong skill to learn.

Geethanjali in its continuous efforts in encouraging students, aspiring for higher education abroad, a session was conducted under the initiative of our principal Dr. Udaya Kumar Susarla to give a wide exposure to the young aspirants. It is mandatory to procure i20 before going for Visa. The i20 is not VISA but it is an eligibility certificate for VISA. However, "the i20 fever" at Hyderabad is an Overseas Education Consultant, conducting University Information Sessions in Hyderabad with their client university in the USA – SUNY Polytechnic Institute (formerly SUNY Institute of Tech, Utica). It is a well known Public University in the New York, USA and comes under State University of New York.

Mr. Tze Teck Sim University International Admission Counselor, for SUNY POLYTECHNIC. While addressing the students as one of the sessions of CACG, he explained the students in detail about the admission process at USA through STEM process (Science Technology Engineering & Management courses..) Students who graduate with Science, technology, engineering and Math(STEM) degree are eligible to remain in the United States for an additional 17 months on an optional practical training (OPT) STEM extension.

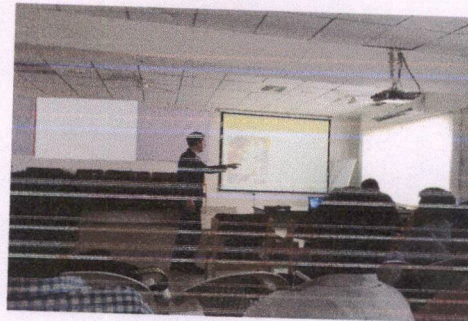

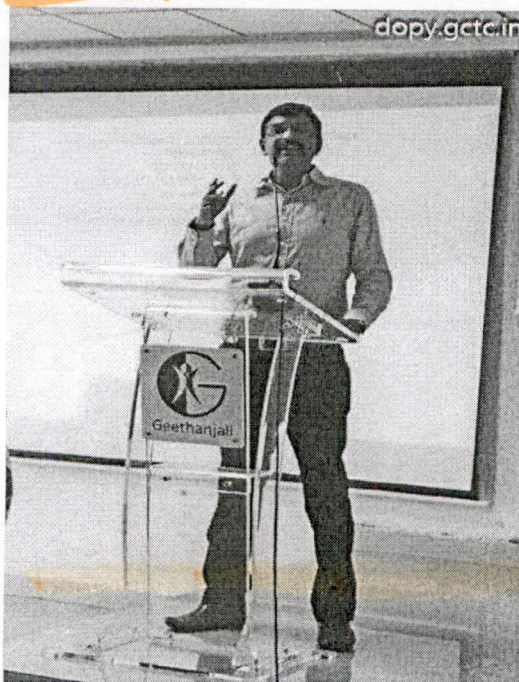

The topic for Debate “Is peer pressure that impacts the youth on drug abuse or individual imbalance.”

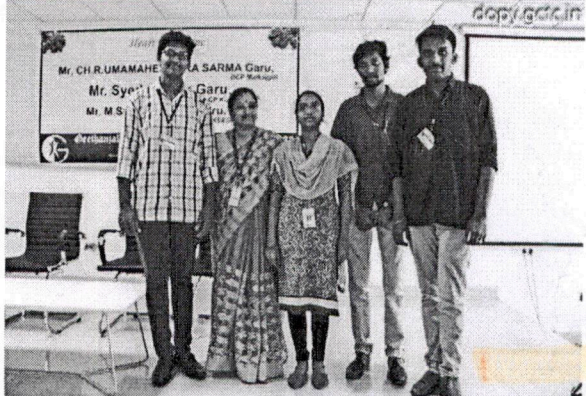
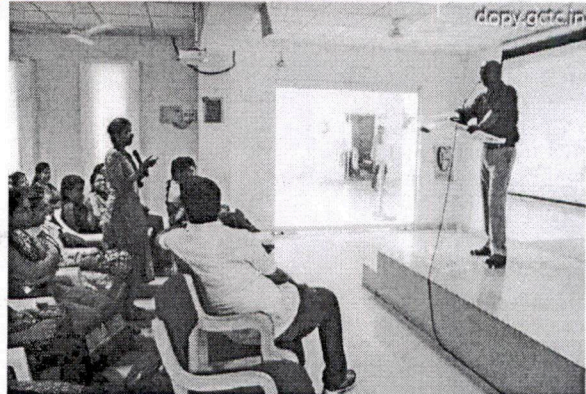
