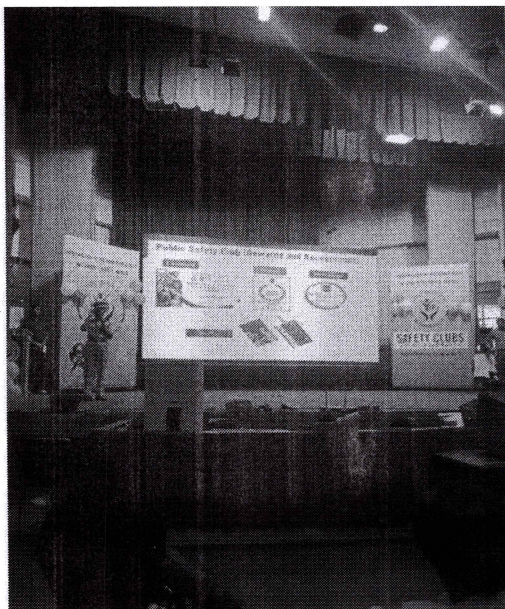
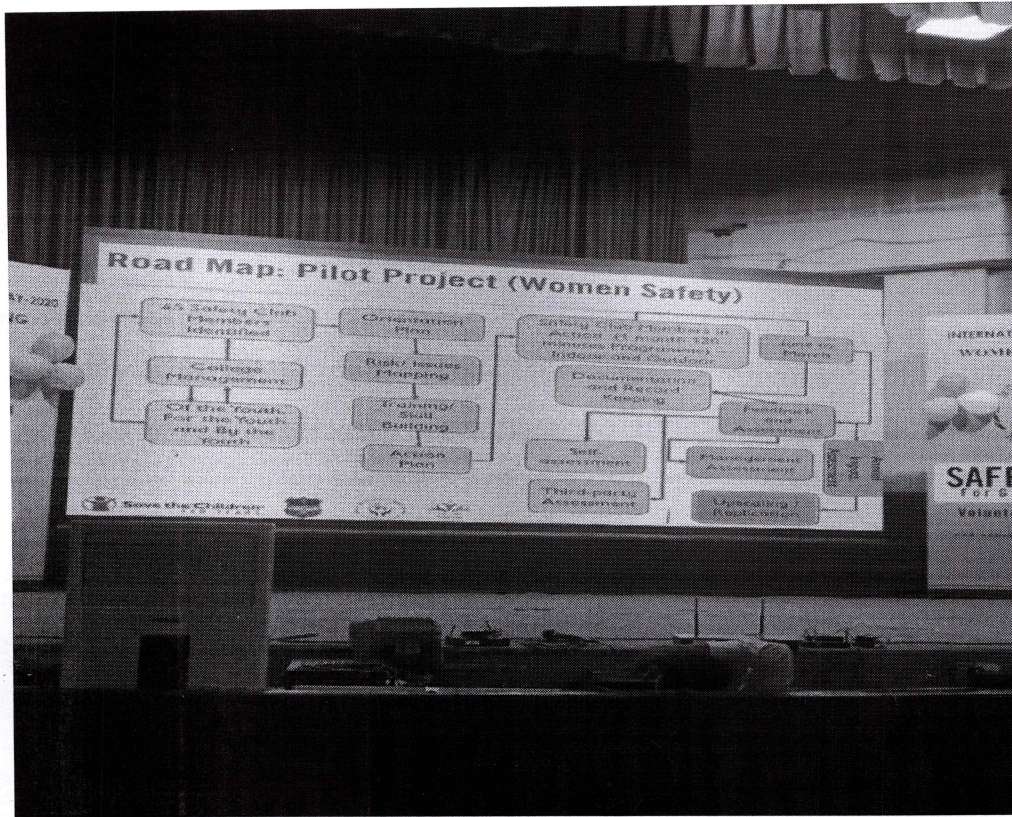
Sri Navin Mittal, IAS, Commissioner of Technical Education addressed the gathering regarding women safety wing importance and how he is willing to express his support for this program.

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
explained how "HAWK EYE" application will work for safety of women and advised to download this application in everyone's mobile.
