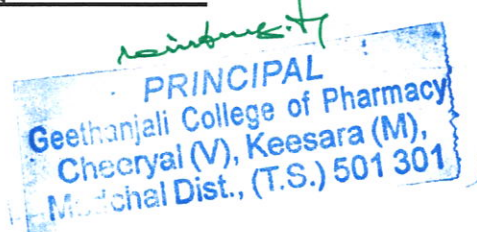
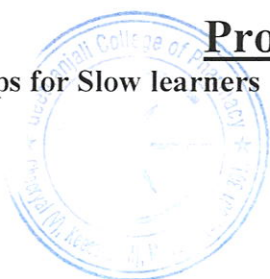
Steps for Advance learners

- Extra classes are organized to clarify doubts. Critical topics are re-explained for better



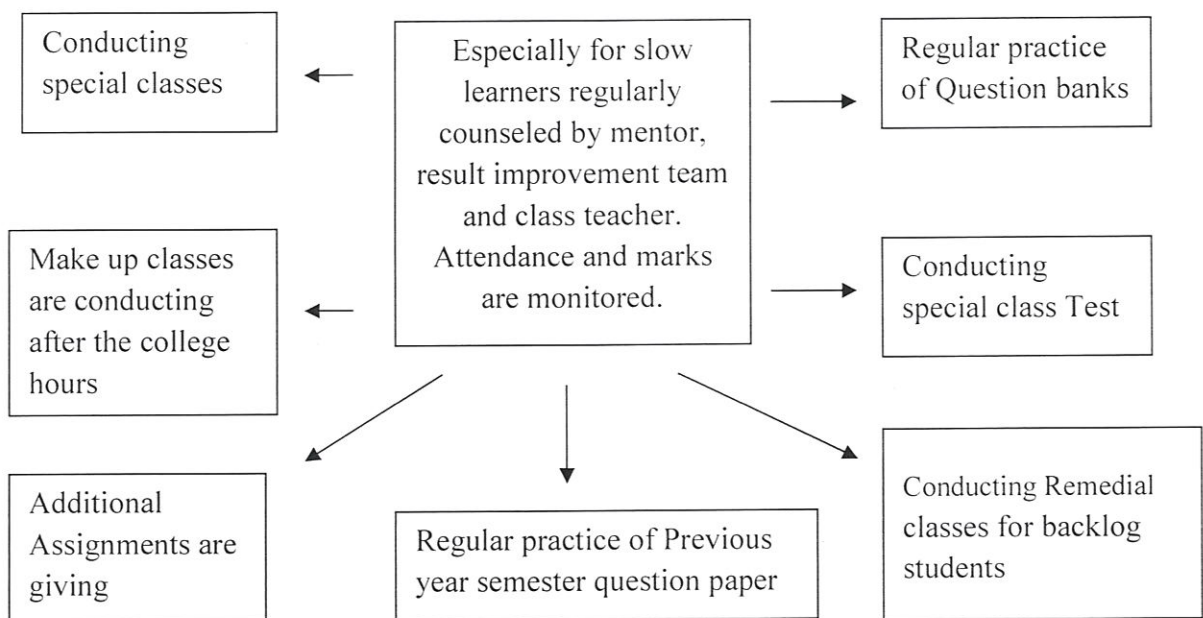
