AND

Whereas, Geethanjali College of Pharmacy Cheeryal (V), Keesara (M), Medchal (Dist), Telangana 501301, Affiliated to JNTUH, Hyderabad, which is represented by its Principal herein named as second party.

A. Objectives of the MOU:

- a. To promote and enhance academic interest between two institutions
- b. To promote research and continuing education activities between institutions

B. Technical Areas of Collaboration:

- a. Provide academic interaction by delivering special lectures on recent advanced topics
- b. Usage of academic infrastructure for students and faculty members.
- c. To facilitate the training for teachers and PG students.
- d. Guidance for enhancement in infrastructural development.

C. Proposed modes of collaboration:

Consortium institutes propose the following:

- a. Co-operation and promotion of education and training are of mutual interest.
- b. A specific plan will be worked out by the institutes depending upon availability of resources.

D. Terms and conditions:

- a. The faculty members and students can use the library on mutual basis for short time use.
- b. Both the institutes agree to help, identify and invite the faculty members and researchers from the other institutes to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses.
- c. Both the institutes can exchange the faculty as Resource persons in order to exchange knowledge.

E. Confidentiality:

- a. Consorted Institutes agree to hold in confidence all information/data designed by the institutes as being confidential during the rendition of MOU and will not disclose the same to the third party without written consent of the other institute.
- b. The above confidential clause under this MOU excludes the information/data possessed by either institute before entering this MOU or independently developed and/or information already available through public domain.

F. Coordination:

- a. Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the program on its behalf.

G. Intellectual Property Rights:

- a. Institutes agree to respect each other's right to Intellectual Property. The Intellectual Property rights that arise as a result of joint research and collaborative activity under the agreement will be worked out on a case-to-case basis and will be consistent with officially laid down IPR policies of the two institutes.

H. Tenure and termination:

- a. This MOU will be in force from the date it is signed by representatives of two institutions for the period of one year.
- b. The agreement will be in legitimacy until it is expressed terminated by either party on mutually agreed terms, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU.
- c. Both the parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days notice in writing. In the event of termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

I. Arbitration Clause:

- a. In case of dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, the authorized person of both the institutes will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared responsibility.

5. The Guide/ Co-Guide / Co-Chairman/Member for the students' advisory committee shall be from Sipra Labs Limited or Geethanjali College of Pharmacy depending on the quantum of research activity, the research team will be constituted by Managing Director, Sipra Labs Limited and Principal Geethanjali College of Pharmacy by mutual agreement.
6. Both parties shall nominate members of their respective staff to work out the practical details of cooperation between the two organizations in general and to ensure proper and effective implementation of this MoU.
7. The work plans developed shall be approved by both the parties for implementation.

III. PUBLICATIONS AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

GCPK has laboratories and research facilities in the areas of Pharmaceutical Sciences and the institute is striving to impart professional training to post graduate students in pharmaceutical Analysis specialization as per the quality assessment needs of drugs, pharmaceuticals and all edible substances and Pharmaceutics specialization as per the production of pharmaceutical formulations and related areas.

YMC Co., is a manufacturer of Equipments, resins, columns and consumables. YMC INDIA is a subsidiary of YMC Co. JAPAN. YMC INDIA - Centre of Excellence Lab was established in 2019 at Hyderabad to provide solutions in analytical and custom purifications. We cater solutions into various industries like Pharmaceuticals, Biopharma, Food, Agriculture, Petro Chemical, Clinical and drug discovery challenges.

“YMC SCHOOL OF CHROMATOGRAPHY” (YSOC) was initiated to collaborate with Academic Institutions/ Universities to share the industrial experiences and provide training to the students/ scholars and to assist in research projects with available excellent infrastructure. Our

Article – I

YMC India Pvt. Ltd will facilitate:

Collaboration in all the areas mentioned below towards mutual benefits and is willing to specifically facilitate:

1. Interaction with GCPK through training the faculty and students in latest technologies from time to time
2. Sharing expertise and training program on basic and applied research in various facets for the PG students, research scholars and staff of GCPK as per the YMC India Pvt. Ltd guidelines from time to time.

GCPK will

1. Provide Facilities (Laboratory, Library and Field) for collaborative research in the areas of mutual interest to both parties as per the agreements from time to time.
2. Encourage the students to attend workshops, Training programs, Internships and Intensive Industrial Training courses.

Joint responsibilities

4. The implementation of the areas and forms of cooperation to be identified shall be subject to the availability and convenience of students, faculty and infrastructure facilities available at YMC India Pvt. Ltd and GCPK.
5. There shall be exchange visits by faculty members and students for academic and research purposes.
6. YMC India Pvt. Ltd offers to permit PG students (number depending on available resources) for a period ranging for 1-6 months to work on thesis-based programs under the joint supervision of YMC India Pvt. Ltd and GCPK staff. GCPK shall arrange to send the list of probable students to YMC India Pvt. Ltd. All the procedures including and requirements will be governed by guidelines of YMC India Pvt. Ltd as per the existing norms of YMC at that time.
7. The Guide/ Co-Guide / Co-Chairman/Member for the students' advisory committee shall be from YMC India Pvt. Ltd or GCPK depending on the quantum of research activity, the research team will be constituted by managing Director YMC, Principal GCPK by mutual agreement.

Article – III

4. The upfront fee and royalty accrued from licensing of any intellectual property arising from this collaboration to other party(ies) shall be for YMC India Pvt. Ltd with due credit to GCPK staff involved.

6. All pre-existing intellectual property rights shall continue to belong to and vest in the Party that owns the same.
7. In the event of any dispute or difference between GCPK and YMC India Pvt. Ltd arising out of or in connection with this agreement such dispute shall be resolved mutually and amicably.

Article IV

FINANCE

YMC India Pvt. Ltd and GCPK shall bear the respective costs of carrying out the obligations under this agreement. Neither party shall make a claim against the other party for any expenditure unless such expenditure has been agreed upon in writing between YMC India Pvt. Ltd and GCPK.

Article – V

This agreement shall be in effect initially for a period of two years from the date of signing of this MoU by both the parties and may be renewed further, if mutually agreed. Either party may terminate the agreement by written notification signed by the appropriate official of the institution indicating the notice. The other party must receive such notice three months prior to the effective termination date.

However, obligations and commitments already contracted for and involving both parties shall be honored and continued by both the parties until such commitments are completed. The present Protocol can be amended by mutual written agreement of the two parties.

No amendment or modification of MoU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties and specifically stating the same to be an amendment of MoU. PREAMBLE

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Memorandum of understanding between Syndy Pharma, Hyderabad AND Geethanjali College of Pharmacy, Cheeryal (V), Keesara (M), Medchal (Dist), Telangana 501301.

1. Preamble

SYNDY PHARMA (Here in after referred as company) is a fast growing manufacturers and exporters of Ayurvedic proprietary products (herbal Cosmetics) using modern day sophisticated machinery to ensure stringent quality, efficacy & purity in all its products. The factory and the operations conform to GMP & ISO 9001:2008 standards. Presently Syndy Pharma doing contract manufacturing for 6 foreign companies and 28 domestic companies.

Geethanjali College of Pharmacy is a fast growing pharmacy college with state-of-the-art facilities and expertise in all aspects of animal studies, formulation development and analytical techniques. The college has got some of the internationally recognized scientists and is dynamic, research driven and dedicated to the cause of serving the public by providing excellent ambience and ample opportunities to its students.

2. The Partners;

The Partners of this Memorandum of Understanding are Syndy Pharma, represented by its Managing Director, **Research and Development and Operations**, Rtn. D.V. Prasad Kumar, (Designated person of the company) AND Geethanjali College of Pharmacy represented by the Principal, Prof. Dr. M. Ravi Kumar (Designated person of the institute).

3. Research Projects:

The research projects involve mainly Formulation and Development studies for Novel drug dosage forms, Pharmacological and Therapeutic activity of the formulations/herbal mixtures/individual herbs formulations developed / under development by Syndy Pharma, Hyderabad.

The said research projects would be undertaken by Geethanjali College of Pharmacy on mutually agreed upon terms and conditions.

4. Terms and Conditions:

- All projects will be coded and correspondence on either side would be through these codes only.
- The work (data to be generated, number of animals, parameters etc.) will be clearly defined, documented and signed by the designated persons. There should be no change in the project work without prior signed consent of both the parties.
- The project cost and phase wise release of the funds will be decided by the designated persons and there will not be any change on the agreed upon terms in this aspect.
- The project and data constitute the exclusive property of company (Syndy Pharma) and no body from the institute including the designated person will claim any right on the data
- The institute will not have any patent rights/market rights /monetary claims enjoyed by the company accrued on the company by utilization of the data generated by the institute.
- We can definitely have joint patents especially on projects involving Government funds and on newer concepts.
- The institute, with prior intimation to the company, can use selected and mutually agreed upon data for publication in scientific` journals/presentation at national and international conferences. However, in all such instances, proper recognition to Syndy Pharma has to be accorded and one of the members of scientific team from the company should also be a co-author.
- The investigating institute will not use the products/compounds/mixtures for any other research/formulation purposes other than for the purpose for which such items have been given to the institute by the company. A written consent has to be obtained by the institute from the company to undertake any such other-than-the project work.
- The institute will give to the designated person/s of the company limited access to examine its facilities and experimental design.
- The company will provide all the necessary information, samples /products as and when required by the institute.
- The institute will adhere to the mutually agreed time frame of the project by the company. The institute will submit the complete project report after completion of the requested experimental studies.-
- The Institute, by undertaking the project work and by entering in to this M.O.U. allows the company to use its name and the scientists in a limited manner for promotion and marketing of company's formulations/products researched by the institute and its scientists.
- Similarly, the institute is permitted to cite this M.O.U. the company and product name while applying for accreditation of the institute, research grants, other approvals, promotion of institution interests, resume of the faculty involved in the project work, institutional goals, development etc

5. Termination of Assigned Project:

- The project can be terminated if both the parties feel so due to unforeseen circumstances / in the best interests of the institute and the company by mutual understanding.

- The company and the institute/the designated persons or other persons on either side will refrain from any activities/statements/propaganda that bring discredit to the image of the other party.

6. Termination of the M.O.U.:

The M.O.U. can be terminated by mutual consent if either of the party is convinced that the M.O.U. failed to live up to its expectations and serve the desired purpose or if it is deemed that continuance of association would be counter-productive to their business/academic interests.

7. Date of Effect

This Memorandum of Understanding will come into effect on the date of signature and will remain in force until either side delivers written notification to the other of its intention to terminate the Memorandum, in which case it will terminate three months after the receipt of such a notification.

8. Modification:

The MOU may be amended by mutual consent through an exchange of correspondences between the two Partners.

In cases of disagreement, the institute and industry wishing to depart from the agreement shall, wherever possible, give three months' notice of its intention to do so. The agreement shall be reviewed after a period of one year.

(b) In order to promote further scholarly Exchange both institutions shall actively consider the exchange of teaching faculty and scholars. Such Exchange shall be the subject of adhoc consultation in future in accordance with needs and feasibility.



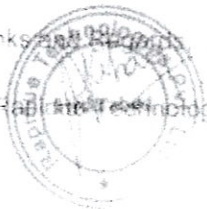


