DESCRIPTION:

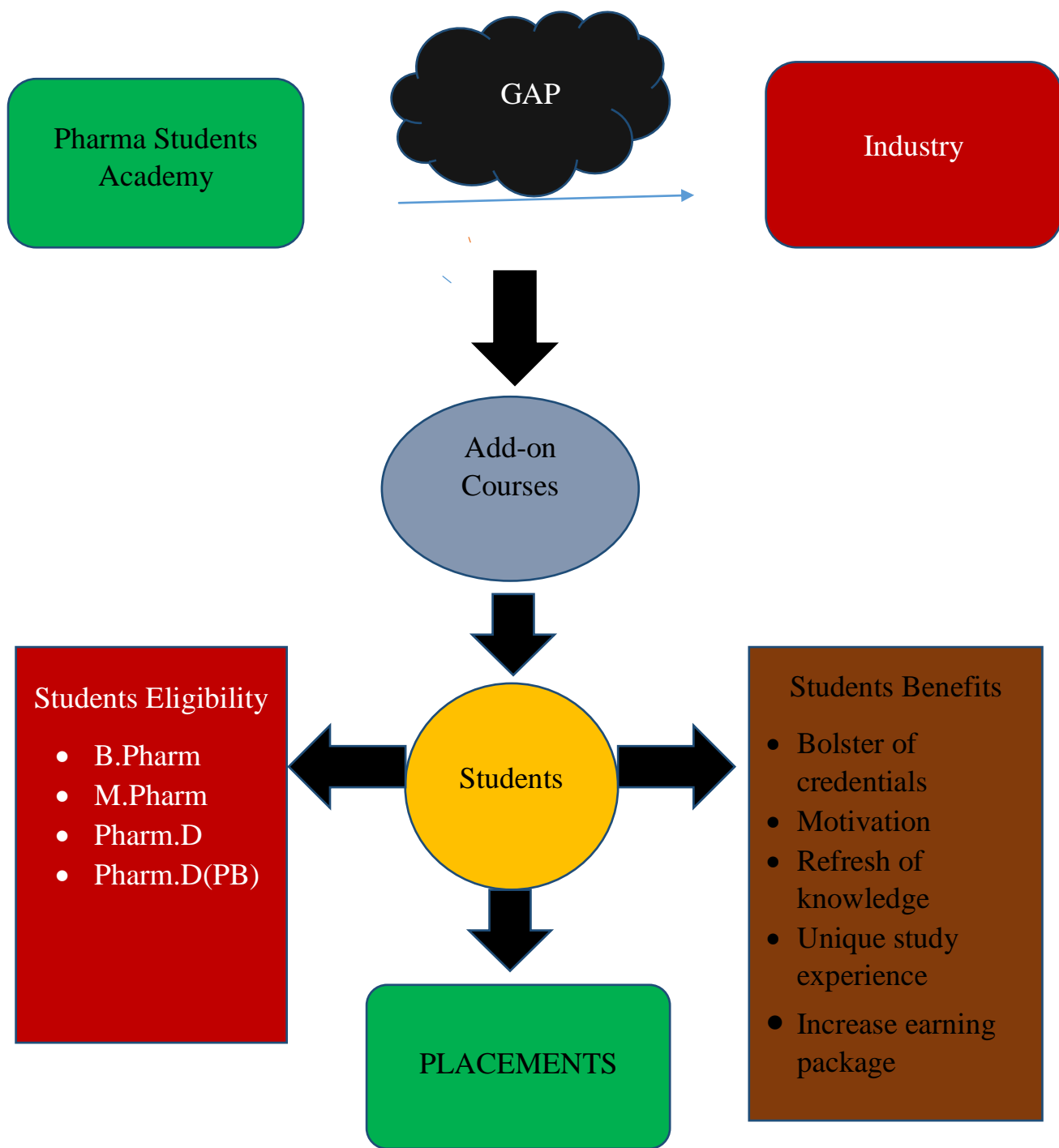

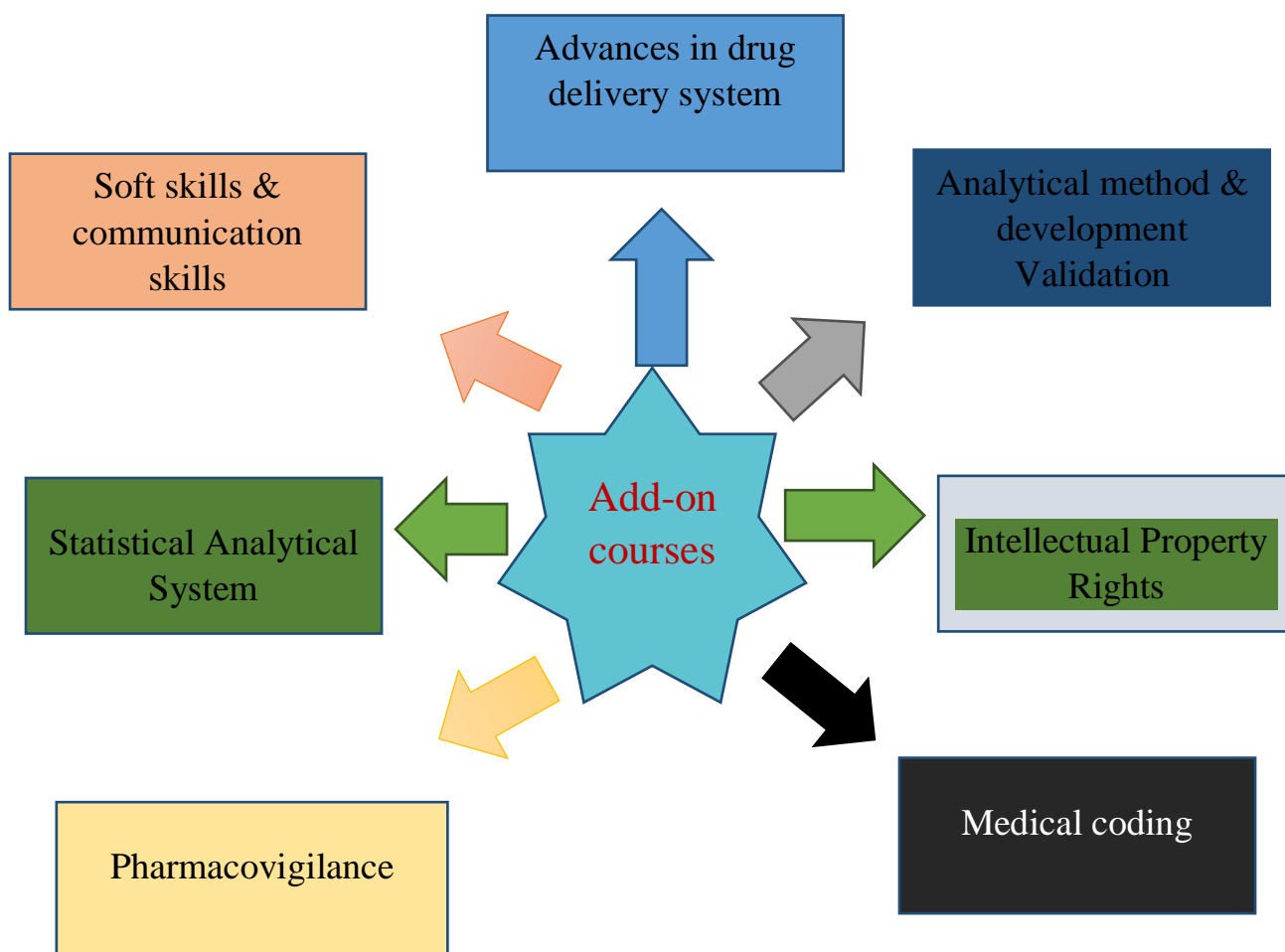
