The lists of candidates who got eligibility to apply for grace, credit exemption and credit exemption followed by grace are already made available in the respective Principals accounts of the results portals. The students may be intimated to apply on or before 17-02-2021 for speedy processing.

For conduction of second mid-term exams which are going to commence in last week of February and first week of March, the parent colleges can choose different host colleges, after taking the options from the students (like in first mid-term exams). For more details about the modalities for conducting second midterm exams, you are informed to go through the previous letter (ref. 3 cited above) wrt modalities for conducting first mid-term exams during December, 2020.

Principals are informed to note that as per University orders(ref. 1& 2) cited above, the candidates who completed specified number of supplementary attempts in addition to one regular attempt need to write the supply exam in the subjects of subsequent regulations, if the syllabus variations are not much. Accordingly question papers of some of the subjects of BTech / BPharm (R13 & R15 regulations), M. Tech. / M. Pharm. (R17 regulations) and MBA/MCA (R15 regulations) which fulfil the above conditions are listed in the Annexure-I. The question papers for these subjects shall not be issued during the forthcoming University exams. Instead, the candidates who register for any of the subjects need to write the supplementary exams in the new equivalent subject offered

insuccessive regulations. The mapping list of new subjects to each old subject is also given in the Annexure-I.

The list of candidates who are eligible for i) CBT exams (those who completed their course work and eligible for internal improvement) and ii) CBT exams followed by special supplementary exams (one-time-chance candidates who are eligible for internal marks improvement) and only special supplementary exams (one-time-chance exam) are made available in the respective Principals accounts of the portal. The Principals are informed to reachall these students through social media and other means and inform them to register for the CBT and/or special supplementary exams. The notification for these CBT and special supplementary (one-time chance) exams shall be issued on 22-02-2021. If any student is eligible to write CBT/Special Supplementary exam, but not listed in Annexure-II (This folder is kept in principals login in others option) , the applications of such students need to be filled in conventional application form given in Annexure-III and submit manually along with demand draft for an amount equal to the examination fee.

The modalities for conducting the UG odd semester regular exams which are commencing from March 8, 2021, shall be communicated shortly.

The cooperation of the Principals is highly solicited.
