Based on the promotion rules specified in R16 and R17 regulation (Ref.1 & Ref. 2), the credit based detentions have been finalized for the promotion from III B.Pharm. to IV B.Pharm., II B.Pharm. to III B.Pharm. and I B.Pharm. to II B.Pharm.

Please find the enclosed provisional credit based detention list of B.Pharm. students along with their Hall Ticket numbers for necessary action. In case of any discrepancies / clarifications, it is requested to bring to the notice of the Director of Evaluation, JNTUH at the earliest.

While computing credits required for promotion, following additional points may be noted:

- 1) Required Credits for promotion have been computed considering the floor values, discarding the fractional component (For example 60% of 96 credits is equal to 57.6, which is truncated to 57).
- 2) For lateral entry students, the required credits for promotion from second year to third year have been reduced to 50% (Ref. 3)

The Principals are informed to provide a copy of R16 regulation to all the final year and a copy of R17 regulations to third year and second year B.Pharm. students (if not provided earlier) and also inform the students that there is no credit exemption from R16 regulations onwards. A declaration must also be taken from the students of R16 and R17 regulations (second, third and fourth year students) to this extent. The format of the declaration is enclosed herewith.
