





I. OBJECTIVES:

The Guide/ Co-Guide / Co-Chairman/Member for the students' advisory committee shall be from Vyas Labs or Geethanjali College of Pharmacy depending on the quantum of research activity, the research team will be constituted by Managing Director, Vyas Labs and Principal Geethanjali College of Pharmacy by mutual agreement.
- 5. Both parties shall nominate members of their respective staff to work out the practical details of cooperation between the two organizations in general and to ensure proper and effective implementation of this MoU.
